Emergency Vehicles will stage on the west bound side of S. Madison St. starting at Webster Street facing south. (Not horns or sirens will be allowed, only lights)

All other entries will get their assigned number and staging location at check in.

Check in for all entries will be at the intersection of Wester St. and Lee St. (You will not be allowed in, if you arrive after 5:30pm)

Parent's that are dropping their kids off to ride on a float, will not be allowed in the staging area. Drop off location for your kids will be at the intersection of Columbus St. and Lee St. A city staff member will walk your child to the correct float.
